Powered by a custom Android 12 OS and professional-grade hardware, this display is ready for any adventure you throw at it.







No external PC required.




Zero Bezel Interference: Full-screen usability —no raised borders to interrupt your game pieces or miniatures.






PLACEMENT GUIDELINES




Only install on secure, load-bearing surfaces.



Leave airflow around all ventilation holes and fan ports.




Avoid exposure to liquids, humidity, or direct heat.




Avoid pressure on the back center of the panel —this can damage internal components.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE


Use a dry microfiber cloth for surface cleaning.




Do not use ammonia, alcohol, acetone, or abrasive cleaners.




Inspect ventilation areas monthly for dust.




If storing long-term, unplug and keep in a dry, cool space.

Voltage: AC 110–240V / 50–60Hz




Always unplug before connecting or disconnecting devices.



REMOTE USE TIPS:

Maintain line-of-sight to IR sensor.



Avoid direct sunlight or bright LEDs during use.



Use matching batteries (AAA). Remove if unused for 30+ days.



TROUBLESHOOTING

No Power

Check outlet, switch on power button (back of screen), replace cable

No Touch Response

Restart system; check cable connections or USB ports to main board

Display Error

Check HDMI/display cable; inspect for physical damage

Wi-Fi Not Detected

Check Wi-Fi antenna, reset network in settings

Bluetooth Not Working

Verify Bluetooth is on; reboot system

Fan Not Running

Check fan cable or dust blockage

No Sound


Check speaker cables and volume settings

SOFTWARE & CONNECTIVITY



HDMI In/Out: Connect consoles, PCs, or external displays



USB Ports: Plug in USB drives, keyboards, and peripherals



Wi-Fi / Ethernet: Connect to the internet for updates and app downloads



Bluetooth: Pair with wireless accessories



Casting: Use eShare to cast from mobile/laptop (retains touchscreen functionality)

Updating System Software:

Updates may be provided by Game Theory Tables.

Download to USB → Plug into screen → Auto-install prompt will appear.

ARENA DISPLAY LIMITED WARRANTY

- **Term:** 1-Year coverage on manufacturer defects.
- **Coverage Includes:** Internal components, power supply, display performance
- **Excludes:**
 - Physical damage (including cracked tempered glass)
 - Liquid damage
 - User modifications or unauthorized disassembly

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The tempered glass is durable but not unbreakable. Exceeding posted weight limits (20 lbs center / 70 lbs edge) voids coverage.
